

ORDINANCE 2022 - 18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021-25 OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOBART, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AMENDING THE HOURLY COMPENSATION RANGE FOR CERTAIN PART TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL FUND: BUILDING MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Common Council ("Council") of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana adopted Ordinance 2021-25 fixing the salaries of officers and employees of the City of Hobart for Fiscal Year 2022 on September 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hobart has recently been advised that pay rates for certain part-time positions throughout the City and the surrounding area have made it difficult to find and retain part-time employees for part-time positions that require security clearances, unusual hours and physical demands within the Building Maintenance Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council, having been advised of these compensation issues and the need to recruit for a part-time building maintenance position, now desires to amend Ordinance 2021-25 regarding part-time building maintenance department employee compensation to bring them more in line with the surrounding area in order to hire and retain the personnel needed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Ordinance 2021-25 be amended as follows:

<u>Part Time Positions:</u>	<u>Fund/Account #</u>	<u>Minimum</u>	<u>Maximum</u>
Building Maintenance	1101 045 113.000	\$ 10.00/hour	\$ 16.00/hour

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION THREE: All other provisions of Ordinance 2021-25 and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
