- Pavement Cutting less than 100 SF: **\$100.00/0.1 miles** or street segment if shorter
- Pavement Cutting of 100 SF or more: **\$300.00/0.1 miles** or street segment if shorter
- Review Fee after 2<sup>nd</sup> plan review: **\$50.00 per each** additional review

D. Under Sewers/Pre-Treatment of Non-Domestic Waste to increase staff inspection time as needed for compliance and monitoring:







Sorry for late notice, but there are some changes I want to make to the fee schedule.

- ↓ Police Officer application fee: From \$40 to \$0 or remove the fee line. We are utilizing a software company that applications will be fillable online and comes with tracking and notification and communication. It charges the applicant a fee and I would like that to be the only fee. It does not charge us for the software, only the applicant. It has shown the majority of applicants are filling applications on smart phones and this will allow them to do this at their cost. ✓
- ↑ Vehicle Towing - from \$20 to \$25 (Almost nobody is less than \$25, some are more) ✓
- ↑ Accident Reports - From \$15 to \$20 (Range in county is \$15 to \$25 and feel this is a good middle of road amount.) ✓
- ↓ Salvage VIN inspection - From \$25 to \$5. Cannot be more than \$5 per state statute and we only do easy ones and send difficult ones to state police where they have a vehicle lift, since we have no vehicle lift for this purpose. ✓
- ↓ Motor vehicle inspection (VIN or HIN inspection): Says \$6, Cannot be more than \$5 and should include language for boats also, not just motor vehicles. IC 9-17-2-12 limits fee to \$5 ✓
- Offense Reports ; We currently collect \$6 per report. Language should read: \$6.00 per report/ .10/page copy fee for FOIA requests. Apparently there is no fee listed for the \$6 we have been charging for years. ✓
