**A Resolution Authorizing the Disposal of Sixty-Five (65) APX-6000 Model 2.5
Portable Radios by the Hobart Police Department**

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety ("Board") of the City of Hobart, Indiana ("City") acts as purchasing agency for the City pursuant to I.C. §5-22-4-5 and Hobart Municipal Code §31.004; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been informed that, as a result of the acquisition of replacement radios, sixty-five (65) used Police Department unsupported APX-6000 Model 2.5 portable radios (H98UCF9PW6AN) have now been decommissioned and are no longer suitable for use by the Police Department and the Department wishes to dispose of them in the manner permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the unsupported APX-6000 Model 2.5 portable radios (H98UCF9PW6AN) are a special sale in that only specialized purchasers able to reprogram the radios to remove all prior information are eligible purchasers, and


WHEREAS, the Police Department has solicited four (4) quotes and determined that the highest quote in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$22,750.00) was submitted by Sunny Communications, Lakewood, CA; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has arranged for the sale of the sixty-five (65) APX-6000 Model 2.5 portable radios (H98UCF9PW6AN) to Sunny Communications, Lakewood, CA.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY of the CITY OF HOBART, INDIANA that:


1. The Board now authorizes the sale of the surplus of Sixty-Five (65) APX-6000 Model 2.5 portable radios (H98UCF9PW6AN) to Sunny Communications, Lakewood, CA for the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$22,750.00).
