

ORDINANCE 2013-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2012-23 OF THE CITY OF HOBART, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA TO EXPAND THE RANGE OF HOURLY PAY RATE FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT PART-TIME RADIO OPERATORS.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana, adopted Ordinance 2012-23 on August 15, 2012, fixing the salaries of officers and employees of the City of Hobart for Fiscal Year 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council now desires to amend said Ordinance to expand the hourly pay rate range of minimum and maximum pay for the part-time police department radio operators.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana as follows:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2012-23 be amended to expand the range of hourly pay rate for part-time radio operators in the Police Department as follows:

<u>POSITION/Line Item</u>	<u>MINIMUM</u>	<u>MAXIMUM</u>
Radio Operators (part-time) 101039113.002	\$ 8.40/hour	\$ 20.00/hour

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided by law.
