

COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOBART, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 2018 - 01

An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Hobart Pertaining to the City Scouting Board

WHEREAS, the Common Council (“Council”) of the City of Hobart (“City”) has been informed that certain changes to the City’s Scouting Board are necessary and desirable to assure proper representation of the scouting community in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City’s young people to provide for an expanded and more diverse membership on the Scouting Board; and

WHEREAS, the Council, through this Ordinance, desires to amend the provisions of the Hobart Municipal Code governing the Scouting Board, accordingly.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Indiana as follows:

SECTION ONE. The Municipal Code of the City of Hobart (“Code”) is hereby amended in §31.20 entitled “PURPOSE,” by striking out the language of said Section and inserting the following new language in lieu thereof:

§31.20. PURPOSE.

A board, to be known as the Scouting Board, is established for the purpose of administering and maintaining properties owned by the City for the use of the Hobart Boy Scouts of America, and the Hobart Girl Scouts of America.

SECTION TWO. The Code is further amended by striking out all of the language of §31.021 entitled “MEMBERSHIP” and inserting the following new language in lieu thereof:

§31.021. MEMBERSHIP.


The Scouting Board shall be made up of five (5) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor for terms of two (2) years or until their successors have been appointed and qualified. Not less than two (2) of such members shall be persons who represent the Hobart Boy Scouts of America, and not less than two (2) of such members shall be persons representing the Hobart Girl Scouts of America. The remaining member of the Board may represent either of those groups. Vacancies among members of the Board

shall be filled by the Mayor for the unexpired portion of the member's term.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption in the manner required by law. Members of the Board who are in office at the passage of this Ordinance shall remain in office for a term of two years, and the new members shall be appointed by the Mayor for like terms.

SECTION FOUR: All other ordinances or portions thereof in effect prior to the effective date and in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.




