RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 07

**A Resolution to Authorize the Solicitation of Competitive Bids
for a New Solid Waste Disposal Services Agreement**

WHEREAS, the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety (“Board”) previously approved, after competitive sealed bids, the execution of a Solid Waste Disposal Agreement, adopted pursuant to the provisions of I.C. §§36-9-30-5 and 36-1-12-4, by and between the City of Hobart, Indiana and Republic Services d/b/a Illiana Disposal Partnership ; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement, pursuant to its terms, was extended twice consecutively for a period of one year each, the most recent extension to expire on December 31, 2018; and


WHEREAS, officials of the City Department of Public Works and the City Administration have advised the Board to authorize the issuance of a Solicitation for Competitive Bids and the publication of Legal Notice thereof in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board, having been so advised desires to authorize the issuance of a Solicitation for Competitive Bids and the publication of Legal Notice thereof so that a new contract for the disposal of the City’s municipal solid waste and post-consumer recyclables will be ready for award prior to December 31, 2018, said Solicitation and Notice to be in substantial conformance with the documents attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibits “A,” and “B,” respectively; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Hobart, Indiana, that:

The Board now authorizes that a sealed competitive bid be pursued for a new solid waste disposal agreement, upon similar terms as previously awarded, and in accord with the solicitation of competitive bids for solid waste disposal services and Notice to Bidders which are attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Board authorizes said Notice to be published in the manner required by law.

ALL OF WHICH is adopted as the Resolution of the City of Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety on this 7th day of November, 2018.

Solicitation of Competitive Bids for Solid Waste Disposal Services

THE CITY OF HOBART BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY ("Board") hereby solicits and requests competitive bids for a contract for solid waste disposal services in accordance with I.C. §§ 36-9-30-5 and 36-1-12-4.

"Solid waste" as that term is used herein, is comprised of the following categories:

1. Refuse (including municipal solid waste)
2. Co-mingled post-consumer recyclables

This solicitation does not include disposal services for white goods, tires or hazardous materials.

Proposed prices must be specified per ton of solid waste. A ton means 2,000 pounds, not a metric ton.

Notice to Bidders in a form approved by the Board shall be published in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the county, two (2) times, at least one (1) week apart, with the second publication made at least seven (7) days before the date the bids will be received, all as required by I.C. §§ 36-9-30-5, 36-1-12-4 and 5-3-1-2 (e).

An **original and six (6) copies** of the completed and sealed bid package must be submitted to the Board of Public Works and Safety, c/o Clerk-Treasurer, 414 Main Street, Hobart, Indiana 46342, on or before **3:00 p.m. Central Standard Time on Wednesday, November 28, 2018**. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer at that date and time. A contract will be awarded by the Board of Public Works and Safety at its public meeting of December 5, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber, Second Floor, Hobart City Hall at the above address.

Since the value of the contract will yield gross revenue to the contractor of at least \$25,000 during the time it is in effect, the following information must be submitted as part of the sealed bid package by each bidder:

- A. A financial statement.
- B. A statement of experience.
- C. The bidder's proposed plan or plans for performing the contract.
- D. The equipment the bidder has available for the performance of the contract.
- E. Certificate of Insurance for the coverage specified on page 3.

F. Non-collusion affidavit.

All of the aforementioned information must be supplied on a completed State Board of Accounts Form 96.

The City of Hobart is seeking bids for solid waste disposal services for the following periods:

- a. Contract commencing January 1, 2019 and continuing through June 30, 2021 (thirty (30) months); and
- b. an option to renew said contract for up to two (2) successive one (1) year terms. The two (2) successive one (1) year terms shall commence on July 1, 2021 and continue through June 30, 2022, and commence on July 1, 2022 and continue through June 30, 2023.

All bid prices must be supplied on the enclosed bid form provided by the City of Hobart. All prices must be specified for all categories of solid waste. Since the disposal of post-consumer recyclables shall be at no cost, no bid price must be supplied for that category. A bid which merely provides an initial cost and then subsequent percentage increases will be considered non-responsive.

Bid prices may not include any minimum number of loads or tonnage to be disposed nor may they include a minimum one (1) ton charge for every load of waste delivered. All bid prices must be specified on a per ton basis and every load must be weighed. Any bid which does not conform to the foregoing requirements will be considered non-responsive. Bid prices must be inclusive of all applicable fees or taxes relating to the disposal. A bid which contains add-ons to the proposed price will be considered non-responsive.

The sealed bid package must also contain the following:

- A. The proposed contract for the services.
- B. A designated through truck route from the City of Hobart to the proposed transfer facility including the mileage to the transfer facility from 1840 East State Road 130, Hobart.
- C. Verification that the contractor maintains all operating permits and licenses required by local, state and federal law.
- D. Verification that the transfer facility will be open during the minimum hours of at least 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. as well as verification that the transfer facility will be open on Saturdays for any week which contains the following holidays if they occur on a weekday:

New Year's Day	Independence Day	Thanksgiving Day
Good Friday	Labor Day	Christmas Day
Memorial Day	Veterans Day	New Year's Eve Day
- E. Verification that the transfer facility will be open beyond the minimum hours stated above for any week in which the above holidays occur.

Each bid package must contain a bid bond or certified check in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposed price for the first 18 months of disposal service. This amount should be based upon the City of Hobart calendar year 2018 approximate tonnage of 11,445 tons of municipal solid waste. The 2018 approximate tonnage for post-consumer recyclables amounted to 2,425 tons. However, this

category does not need to be included in the amount of the bid bond or certified check. The amount of the bid bond or certified check shall be subject to forfeiture to the City of Hobart in the event that the bidder refuses to enter into a contract after the award to the bidder or in the event that the bidder withdraws its bid before the award of the contract.

Each bid must provide the address of the transfer facility to which the municipal solid waste will be delivered. Only one site may be provided. Each bid must provide a written guaranty that this transfer facility will remain available for disposal through the potential fifty-four (4 ½) year duration of the contract. Bids which do not include this guaranty or which propose alternate delivery sites will be considered non-responsive. The city may take into account its increased costs to deliver refuse to a distant transfer point in awarding the contract.

Each bid must include the name and address of all possible landfills which the bidder will use for final disposal.

Each bid must contain evidence of ability to conduct business in the State of Indiana as well as evidence of insurance coverage for worker's compensation, employer's liability, commercial liability, vehicle liability and comprehensive and general liability. The successful bidder will be required to add the City of Hobart as an additional insured to its liability insurance policies.

Bid prices and other information submitted by each bidder shall be used to award a contract to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

The City of Hobart reserves the right to award a contract for the exclusive right to dispose of solid waste.

The City of Hobart also reserves the right to award a contract for each category of solid waste separately to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder if there is a financial advantage to the City of Hobart in doing so.

A bidder who provides a bid price for any category of solid waste agrees it is obligated to enter into a disposal contract with the City of Hobart for a single category of solid waste if its bid for that category is selected as the lowest responsible and responsive bid.

The City of Hobart also reserves the right to waive any formalities or compliance with non-material aspects of the specification with the exception of those required by I. C. § 36-9-30-5(d).

The City of Hobart also reserves the right to reject all bids.
