## 2016 ADA YEAR END REPORT

The Mayor's ADA budget was \$30,000.00. The actual amount spent for ADA compliances by the City was \$874,672.40. We replaced several blocks of sidewalks, new curbs, new ADA corners, curb ramps and streets. The breakdown is as follows:

Our Park Department updated some parks with ADA approved park equipment, installed some sidewalks and benches. The Park Department installed a Kayak/Canoe launch on the Deep River side of Lake George. The ramp was built to ADA specifications and can be used by both right and left hand users.


The Street (Public Works) Department continued their annual summer project of marking (striping) our streets, corners and crosswalks to ADA standards.

Work that was done by the Sanitary/Stormwater Department in regards to curbs, corners, sidewalks and streets were completed to conform to ADA specifications.

The Economic Development Commission (EDC) and the Board of Works (BOW) completed a very extensive gateway project and built a new parking lot Downtown. The gateway project divided Old Ridge Road with landscaped islands. The islands were divided by ADA approved crosswalks and were lighted. The EDC and the BOW also worked together to start redeveloping our old Brickie Bowl (football field) to a more modern facility to attract different users of the facility, concerts, etc. All work being done with ADA requirements in mind.

We updated our webpage to include some items that the State of Indiana ADA Department wanted added. We had to tweak a couple of other requirements to be compliant. The good news is we passed.

I attended several ADA training sessions in order to keep up with the ever changing rules and regulations and to maintain our compliance with the State. I believe our ADA program had a very successful year.
