## 2018 ADA YEAR END REPORT

The City of Hobart had a very busy year in regards to street construction projects that incorporated several ADA projects. There are many pictures and information to back up this claim in our 2018 year end scrapbook. The book can be viewed anytime in the City of Hobart Clerk - Treasurer Office.

We replaced about 4000 square feet of sidewalks throughout the City thru the 50/50 sidewalk program. Twenty-one Hobart residents participated in the program. The City spent \$31,797.16 dollars as their share of the 50/50 sidewalk replacement program.

We spent \$80,650.78 dollars replacing curb ramps throughout the City and a total of \$1,495,665.08 dollars for all street work, new sidewalks, gutters and street lights.

There were many projects that were completed and some that will not be completed until 2019. These projects were funded partially by federal funds, INDOT funds and local tax dollars. There are pictures of these projects in our 2018 scrapbook in the following folders: Sidewalks, curbs, corners, streets and parks.

I attended several ADA training sessions in Indianapolis and other locations throughout the year. Bob Fulton, our Title VI Coordinator, also attended training sessions. We held a training session for all City of Hobart employees of which ADA and Title VI policies and procedures were discussed and questions answered. Our next project that we have to address is the Bus Transit System that effects Hobart.

The City of Hobart had a great ADA year in 2018.
