


## SERV DIVISION MISSION STATEMENT

## System to End Repeated Violence SERV Division

The SERV Division recognizes that domestic or family violence (domestic disturbance) calls a high priority. The nature and seriousness of crimes committed between family or household members are not mitigated because of the relationships or living arrangements of those involved. Therefore, the SERV team makes this a priority to respond to Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking and provide immediate services based upon the Lethality Assessment, Needs Assessment, and the criminal justice process. With all due consideration for their own safety, department personnel responding to a domestic disturbance call (SERV) shall attempt to restore order, provide safety and security for the crime victim(s) and help participants contact appropriate resources for shelter, legal needs medical or mental health needs and to prevent future occurrences.

## meet our team

The Hobart Police Department SERV team consists of a supervisor, a lead investigator, victim's services coordinator, and an administrative assistant. We also have sworn officers assigned to our program.

**Detective CPL Robert Brazil** is the Hobart Police Department SERV team supervisor. Detective Brazil is in charge of reviewing daily calls for service and assigning it to the SERV team for further follow up with the victim. Det Brazil also oversees the daily duties of the SERV team and makes sure everything is running accordingly.

**Detective Stephanie Stewart** is the Hobart Police Department SERV lead investigator. Detective Stewart reviews cases and determines if further investigation or criminal charges will need to be filed.

**Andrea Graciano** is the Hobart Police Department SERV team Victim Services Coordinator. Andrea provides relevant services to individuals affected by crimes such as domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking related calls. Some of these services include crisis intervention, safety planning, brief therapy, assisting with obtaining financial support, coordination of services, ect.

**Samantha Bull** is the Hobart Police Department SERV team administrative assistant. Samantha is in charge of tracking all domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking related calls. Samantha reaches out to victims daily to schedule appointments and ensure their safety and well being. She also tracks all required information for both of our grants.

**The Sworn Officers** assigned to the Hobart Police Department SERV division shall complete daily follow ups for calls in relations to Domestic Violence. The SERV team shall complete a Domestic Violence Assessment to determine the risk of further escalated violence, as well as if further and more in-depth follow up is needed by the Victims Services Coordinator.
