



2022 ADA Year End Report

The City of Hobart secured the Community Crossings Matching Grant Fund through INDOT, and spent a total of \$89,238.62 on ADA items. These items included adding and refurbishing curb ramps and sidewalks. These improvements, along with a full road reconstruction occurred on 3rd St from Wisconsin St to Ash St, and Delaware St from Cleveland Ave to Home Ave.

In addition to the above, our Parks Department secured the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs' Community Development Block Grant for \$157,206.1 on ADA walkaway to the playgrounds within 7 parks.

City Hall also had some renovations done to the building, which included a new main entrance to help bring the building into ADA compliance, and was \$52,200.

The City of Hobart did not use the sidewalk 50/50 program this year, but we did spend a total of \$298,644.71 in ADA improvements.

An ADA complaint was received by the City in regards to the lack of an accessible parking stall at 250 S Washington St. The city is still actively working with the property owner to bring the property into compliance, and hopes to have this resolved by early 2023.
