- I. The Plan Commission meets on the first Thursday of every month at 7:00 p.m. Applications are due the Tuesday directly following a regularly scheduled Plan Commission meeting. If applications are filed after the deadline and can meet state notification requirements, they may pay twice the applicable fee and be placed on next Plan Commission agenda.
- II. Filing Fee:
 - a. Residential/Agriculture: \$100.00 plus \$5.00 per acre or any portion thereof
 - b. Commercial/Industrial: \$200.00 plus \$5.00 per acre or any portion thereof

For all zone changes there is a \$35.00 fee public notice frame and sign for public notice, \$20.00 of which is refundable once frame is returned with receipt.
- III. Filing Checklist;
 - a. Plat of Survey with complete legal description and acreage. A deed may also be required.
 - b. Concept Plan drawn to scale with all building lines, setback requirements, easements, access, and location and distances from property line of any existing or proposed structures.
 - c. Application completed and notarized. If the petitioner is not the owner, a completed Power of Attorney form must be submitted with application.
 - d. Mail petition packet to board members of the Hobart Plan Commission. (see attached for member list)
 - e. Legal Advertisement placed in a paper of local circulation 10 days prior to public hearing. Proof of publication must be presented to staff prior to public hearing.
 - f. Notification of adjacent property owners. The list is generated by City of Hobart Staff. Petitioner is responsible to contact via certified US Mail and return certification to staff prior to public hearing.
 - g. Place sign and frame at location at least 10 days prior to public hearing.
 - h. Comments from local, state, and federal agencies as deemed necessary by Planning Department.

IV. Appear before City Council for final approval.
