

## Dam Duck Tape & Cardboard Regatta Race Rules

- 1.) The entire construction of the boat's hull is strictly made of corrugated CARDBOARD. The cardboard boat can be as thick as you want it to be. It can be attached with duct tape, adhesives, and one-part paints. NO epoxy paints or caulking allowed. NO nails, staples, or metal allowed. NO wood, plastics, wax, or Styrofoam allowed.
- 2.) Design is the builder's choice. Let your imagination run wild! Costumes and team attire are encouraged.
- 3.) All participants racing on a boat MUST have a life jacket on.
- 4.) All race participants MUST sign a waiver and release agreement.
- 5.) Anyone under the age of 16 years old MUST have an adult on the boat with them. They must also have a parent/guardian sign their waiver.
- 6.) Crew members MUST be able to swim to participate. Water is not deep but we ask that racers be prepared to possibly go down with the ship.
- 7.) Anyone found guilty of illegal boat materials will be DISQUALIFIED.
- 8.) Only paddles/oars can be used to manually propel you through the water.
- 9.) Please remove all of your "shipwreck" debris and dispose of it properly in the provided dumpsters.
