

Hobart Launches Transit Feasibility Study

The City of Hobart and the Northwest Indiana Regional Planning Commission (NIRPC) have kicked-off a transit feasibility study. The purpose of the study is to evaluate how people travel in and around Hobart to determine if there are cost-effective options for addressing transportation needs through transit service.

The transit feasibility study, funded through a grant from NIRPC, will be completed over the next year and residents will have a number of opportunities to provide input to the decisions.
